Once your child has fully recovered, we will be delighted to welcome them back to school with open arms.

In the interim, we will make every effort to provide your child with educational materials and resources to help them keep up with their studies while they are at home. Our teachers will be available to answer any academic questions via e-mail or other communication channels.

If there are any updates or changes in your child's health status, kindly inform the school at the earliest, so we can take necessary precautions and provide appropriate support.
